

AFGS CATALOG Instructions

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The Catalog contains an index of over 20,000 repertoires and books in the AFGS library. It is arranged alphabetically by place name, but a brief explanation is needed to ensure you find what you need.

Each shelf of books at the library has a placard on the end of the rack, listing what place codes are on each side of the book rack. The placard comes in handy to help you determine which rack holds the book you need. Each book binding contains the 'Book Number' and 'Place Code', as well as a colored tag that is related to the place code.

There are only two things you need to locate a book on the shelves:

Book Number from column 1.

Place Code(s) from column 2 (and 2a, if it is listed). See Appendix-2 for a complete listing.

The catalog format is typically divided into five columns:

Notes:

[1] a book number of 'XXX' means it is filed elsewhere. For example; "Wedgeport, NS, Acadia" is in "NVS YAR 004".

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[2] the county code (2a) is not always included. It may be blank or be 'XXX' meaning no county listed.

Column-4 describes the date range covered within the book.

Column-5 describes the type of information contained in the book. See Appendix-1 for a list of codes.

How to read the catalog entries:

Example-1: shows five books for the State of Connecticut, USA (UCT place code):

Explanation:

Row-1: Book 003 contains Death records (D) for Putnam, Windham County (WIN), Connecticut (UCT) for the years 1920-1969.

Row-2: Book 004 also contains Putnam Death records (D), but for the years 1970-1990.

Row-3: Book 007 has Births, Marriages & Deaths for Sacred Heart Church in W. Thompson, Windham County, CT for the years 1948-1990.

Row-4: Book 002 contains Marriages for Sacred Heart Church in Taftville, New London County, CT for the years 1883-1924.

Row-5: Book 001 contains Marriage records for St-Ann Church, Bristol, Hartford County, CT for the years 1908-1977.

Example-2: shows two books for Chateaugay County (CHT) in the Province of Quebec:

Explanation:

Row-1: Book 007 contains marriage records for St-Jean-Chrysostome parish in Chateaugay, Quebec for the years 1838-1990.

Row-2: Book 003 contains marriage records for St-Joachim parish in Chateaugay, Quebec for the years 1736-1963.

Example-3: shows three books for Acadia (ACA) in Canada:

Explanation:

Row-1: Book 027 contains Marriages from the Baie-des-Caleurs Registers in Acadia for the years 1786-1799.

Row-2: Book 269 contains Births, Marriages & Deaths for Barachois in Acadia for the years 1812-1870.

Row-2: Book 142 contains History for Gaspesie, Bas-St-Laurent in Acadia.

APPENDIX-2 PLACE CODES

United States Place Codes:

United States Place codes may identify the 'State' and 'County' for U.S. locations, but the county may be omitted.

U.S. 'State' codes typically contains the letter 'U' (for U.S.), followed by the two-letter abbreviation for the State. For example; 'URI' represents Rhode Island, 'UMA' represents Massachusetts, and 'UME' represents Maine.

A 'County' code may follow the U.S. State code, as a 3-letter acronym for the county name.

For example; 'UMA WOR' represents Worcester County, Mass., and 'URI BRI' represents Bristol County, Rhode Island.

Canadian Place Codes:

Canadian Place codes may identify the 'Province/Territory' and 'County' for Canadian locations, but the county may be omitted.

Listings for the Province of Quebec may only contain a 'County' code for the location.

Listings for outside of Quebec Province may use place codes that identify the 'Province' and 'County'[3], but county may be omitted.

[3] County references are only valid up to 1979, when they were organized as Regional County Municipalities (RCMs).

For examples;

1. a Quebec Province place code might be 'ABI' for Abitibi, or 'GAT' for Gateneau, with both being in Quebec Province.
2. a place code outside of Quebec might be 'ONT SUD' for Sudbury, Ontario; or 'NBK RST' for Restigouche, New Brunswick.
3. but, a place code outside of Quebec might only list the Province, like 'ONT' for Ontario Province, or 'YKN' for Yukon Territory.

Foreign Country Place Codes:

Listings for Foreign countries (beyond Canada) only include a 3-letter country abbreviation as the 'Place Code'. For example; 'FRA' represents France, and 'GBR' represents Great Britain.
